- Support, elaboration and approval of investigations on deviations, OOS / OOE and Complaints; evaluation and approval of CAPA measures and risk assessments
- Execution of batch release in compliance with cGxP and registration (in accordance with approval responsibility)
- Participation in and evaluation of changes in the process and specifications
- Collaboration in or management of project teams; participation in the preparation of Quality Assurance Agreements in line with Novartis Quality Manual & Policies
- Preparation and participation in audits and inspections; participation in and approval of APQR / APR; participation in and implementation of training Responsibility for release; support OpEx improvement projects
- Reporting of technical complaints / adverse events / special case scenarios related to Novartis products within 24 hours of receipt
