- Ensure the correct execution of demand & supply planning transactions in the ERP Mainframe (SAP/R3) for the CPO portfolio. Perform the SAP Super User Role of SAP R/3 demand planning and purchasing module.
- Coordinate with the Marketing Franchises, BPA and SFE the planning, supply and distribution of medical samples for direct business portfolio.
- Ensure excellence in the execution of LCM events and Launches in the CPO. Support the inclusion of BD&L businesses. Update and ensure timely update of weekly NOSSCE stock outs report.
- Ensure compliance of NFCM applicable cockpits. Lead the on-time and accurate update of Supply Planning matters with stakeholders in business meetings as MBR, Supply Reviews with BD&L or NVS team, weekly stock outs reviews, Sales Status, AMC (SCM segment), Inventory levels and /WO review,
